After a well-deserved summer holiday, and an extra shot of motivation due to the excellent results earned on the Endurance Series at Paul Ricard and Spa, it's "back to the office" for Andy Soucek this weekend, who will have to switch to Sprint modus for the penultimate race of the 2017 Sprint Series at Budapest circuit.

The features of the Hungarian track, tight and twisty, do not especially fit the Bentley, nor do they encourage overtaking in general. On top of that, high temperatures are expected, a further complication for turbocharged cars.

Although the Bentley Boys in the #8 car are leading the Endurance Series with just the Season Finale at Barcelona left, in the Sprint Series matters are not going as smooth, and they will try to score as many points as possible in Budapest towards the GT Series championship, which combines Sprint and Endurance Series. Bentley Team M-Sport is currently ranking second in the Team standings, only five points behind the leader.

The qualifying race starts on Saturday at 15:50 CET, and the Main Race will start on Sunday at 14:20 CET.
