## Andy Soucek to fulfil his "American Dream" competing in the SprintX Series in the US

Bentley Motorsport have announced that Andy Soucek will participate in SprintX, as part of the Pirelli World Challenge (PWC).

The Spaniard will be driving the Bentley Continental GT3 for Team K-PAX Racing, the championship-winning team in 2016 with Portuguese driver Alvaro Parente.

Soucek will be sharing the #9 car exactly with Parente, his friend and former teammate in Spanish F3 and GP2 back in 2002 and 2008 respectively.

The SprintX Series races have a duration of one hour each, with a mandatory pit stop for driver and tyre change.

Soucek comments about his American challenge:

"To compete in the US has been one of my dreams and the market is growing a lot over there, with many important racing series such as PWC, IMSA etc.

I am therefore delighted to be able to compete in the SprintX Series. I am especially excited to do so alongside my friend and colleague Alvaro Parente, so apart from being competitive, we hope to enjoy the experience as well. I'd like to thank K-PAX Racing and Bentley Motorsport for enabling me to take on this new challenge.

I'll be having a very complete schedule this year, and I am more encouraged than ever before. I've got 13 races worldwide to compete in, which will enable me to fight for three championships: the Blancpain Endurance Series, Intercontinental GT Challenge and the SprintX Series."
