

Andy Soucek's next challenge has taken him to the Far East this week, as he will be back in his #8 M-Sport Bentley Continental for the Suzuka 10 Hours as part of the Intercontinental GT Challenge.

After the Bathurst 12 Hours in Australia and the Spa 24 Hours in Europe, the event held at this 3.609 mile-long Japanese track will be the third of this four-race Series, each one held on a different continent.

Their encouraging display during the first part of the Spa 24 Hours has made the Bentley Boys confident to be able to score a good result at the historic Suzuka venue to play a role in the championship fight.

Soucek has never raced at Suzuka before, although he competed in Japan twice before and fell in love with country, lifestyle and motor racing fans alike. He has been testing the track on the simulator extensively and hopes to adapt to the track and the quite unusual race duration of 10 hours quickly. On top of that, weather may be an important factor at Suzuka. For the moment, rain is forecasted intermittently for the whole weekend, so finding a good set-up for the wet might as well be crucial.
