

Andy Soucek faces the last Endurance race of the 2018 Blancpain GT Series with high hopes of finishing the European part of his schedule with a positive result.

For his home race at Montmeló (Barcelona) he counts on the support of his family, friends and fans to try to place the M-Sport Bentley #8 amongst the top spots.

Apart from that, the Continental GT3, which had its first outing only at the start of the year, has proved to be highly competitive all along the 2018 Season.

The track located close to his Catalan home has been resurfaced a few months ago, with the new asphalt providing an improved grip level. This will help to reduce tyre wear and enable drivers to squeeze out more fast laps out of each new set.

Qualifying will take place on Sunday at 09:00 CET and the three-hour race will start at 15:00 on that same day.
