

The last race on Andy Soucek's 2018 schedule has brought him back to the US, where he will be taking part in the Laguna Seca Raceway California 8 Hours next weekend, as part of the Intercontinental GT Challenge.

After hours in the simulator and of physical preparation, the Spaniard is highly motivated to compete on this track, a real classic amongst the racing community.

Their last results, a P6 finish in Suzuka and a P4 in Barcelona, clearly point out the evolution of the Bentley Continental GT3 all along the 2018 season. In terms of reliability and performance, the car arrives at the final stage of the season at its peak.

It will be a difficult race due to the level of the 33 competing cars and their drivers, and also because the grip characteristics of the Californian track are very low, which will make the set up work even more challenging.

Still, Soucek and his colleagues in the #8 car hope to adapt quickly to the track and to be able to finish the season on a high.
